

## Annual Report for 2016

In 2016 the Eureka Connection has established a spinoff NFP social business **Living Connected** (<http://livingconnected.org.au/>).

Living Connected provides a service for the social well-being of older people living at home by assisting them to set up and use a computer whereby they remain connected and engaged. This consists of an integrated and individualised program to reconnect older people who are becoming increasingly isolated as they age.

In doing this we have joined the business incubator, iAccelerate, at the University of Wollongong. This was a competitive process involving an application and interview. iAccelerate has provided guidance and mentoring in setting up the Living Connected as a not-for-profit social enterprise

We have formed partnerships with local aged-care providers and plan to begin trading early 2017

Meanwhile we have continued to run computer classes in IRT aged care facilities and follow the progress of the one we set up in the St Georges Basin Masonic Village
